Keeping Our Community Safe and Healthy

- Flagstaff City has an ordinance that requires dogs to be under control of a competent person and restrained by a **leash** when off the premises of their owner. This includes the city's Urban Trail system and parks (except fenced dog parks).
- Coconino County requires every person owning a dog to purchase a license when the dog is three months of age or within 30 days of moving to the County. You can find the dog license application at: www.coconino.az.gov/DocumentCenter/View/443. The completed application, your dog's rabies vaccination record, and the appropriate fee must be mailed or taken to 2625 N King St., Flagstaff, AZ 86001. The phone number is: 928-679-8756.
- When you register your car, get a **Pets Enrich Our Lives license plate** and help in the battle of pet overpopulation.
